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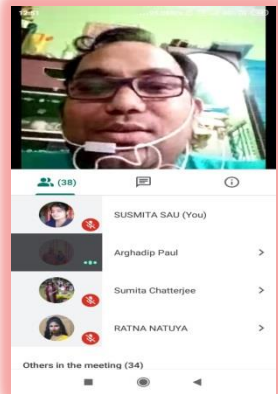

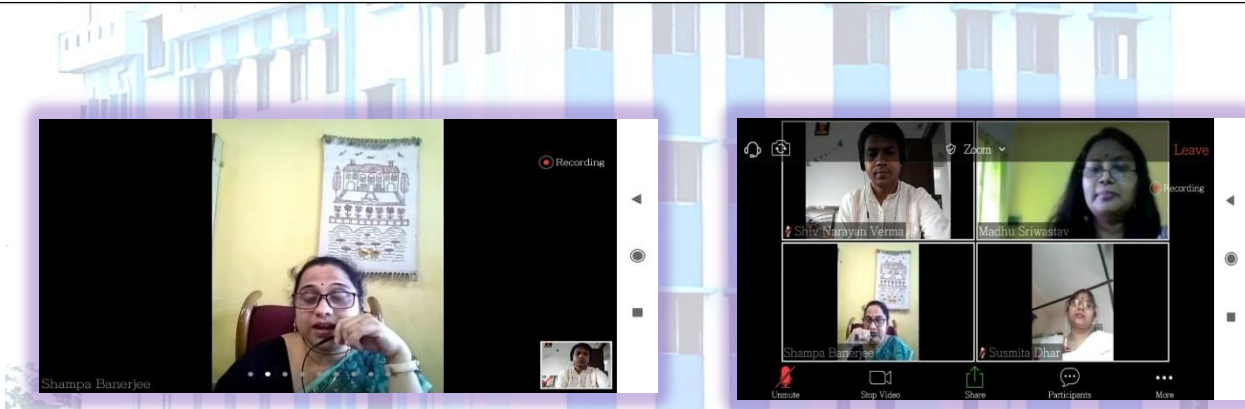
## Principal's Corner

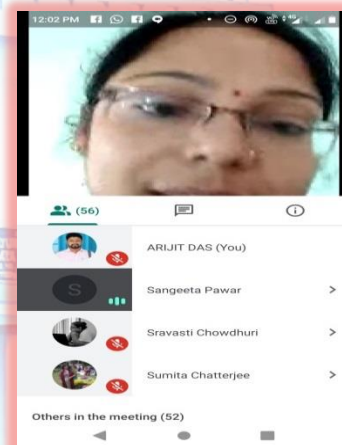
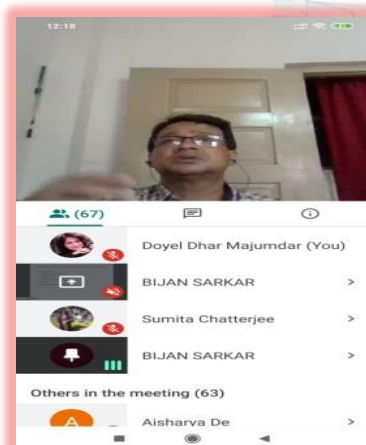


Students participated by making posters regarding the awareness of corona and environmental awareness.

## Education During lockdown

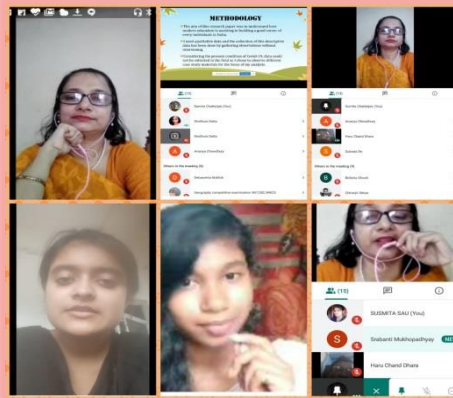
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## Abstract

## Difficulties of Online Education During the Lockdown Period

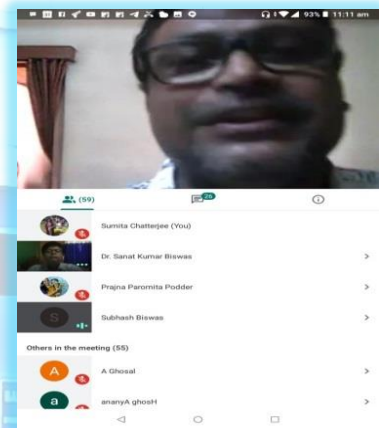
