

Report of Programme titled 'A Fortnight in Reteaching' organized by the Remedial Cell, BHKMahavidyalaya in June 2021

Introduction

The covid pandemic has affected the teaching learning process to a great extent. The online classes, lagging of semester exams created an academic crisis for many. To deal with the situation the Remedial Cell of BHKMahavidyalaya decided to conduct revision classes for students of Department of Sociology through reteaching lessons already dealt with in regular classes. The main reason for this decision is the lagging of university exams due to covid restrictions. Even though students are promoted to successive semesters, their exams lag behind. The revision classes were conducted for a fortnight before university exam dates so that students will find it easy to prepare for exams. The revision classes got very good responses from the students and all the students actively participated in the classes. The classes were offered in the online platform in google meet.

Objectives

The objectives of the programme titled 'A Fortnight in Reteaching' were as follows:

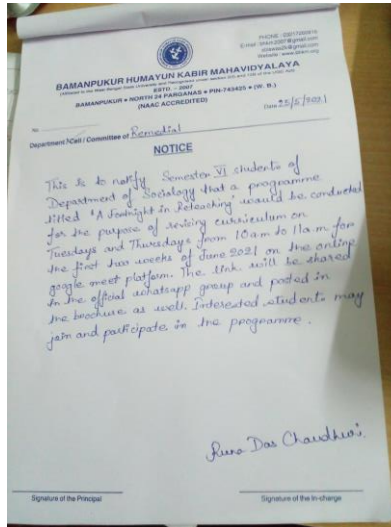
1. To motivate and help the academically weaker students to realize their weakness and help them to improve on their academic fronts.
2. Improving academic skills of the students.
3. Raising their level of comprehension of the subject matter of sociology to provide a stronger for further academic work.
4. To strengthen student's knowledge skills and attitude in the discipline of Sociology

Details of the programme

In the course of teaching process during regular class lectures, slow learners and under achievers are identified. The head of the department of Sociology initiated this programme to keep a record of the academically poor students. It was decided that course content already taught in regular classes would be repeated again for these students. Two weekly tests were conducted at the end of each week. These classes were offered by Dr. Runa Das Chaudhuri, HOD, Department of Sociology, BHKM. Answer scripts of the organized weekly tests were shown to the students drawing their attention to the areas of knowledge deficiency, misconception and inability to express knowledge. The instructor tried her level best to make the students familiar with the basic concept of the discipline. A total of nine students participated in the programme. The programmes were conducted for sixth semester students from 10a.m. to 11 a.m. twice a week on Tuesdays and Thursdays. The classes were held on 1/6/2021, 3/6/2021, 8/6/2021 and 10/6/2021. In the course of teaching learning process during regular classes

and counseling approaches are undertaken. Fortnightly record of progress and attendance was maintained by the teacher concerned.

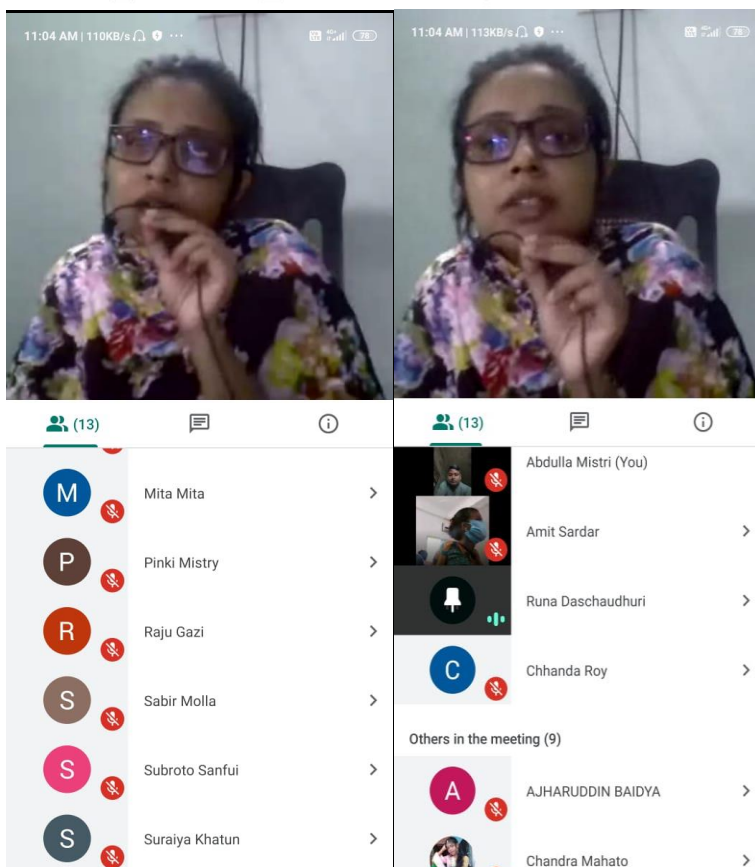
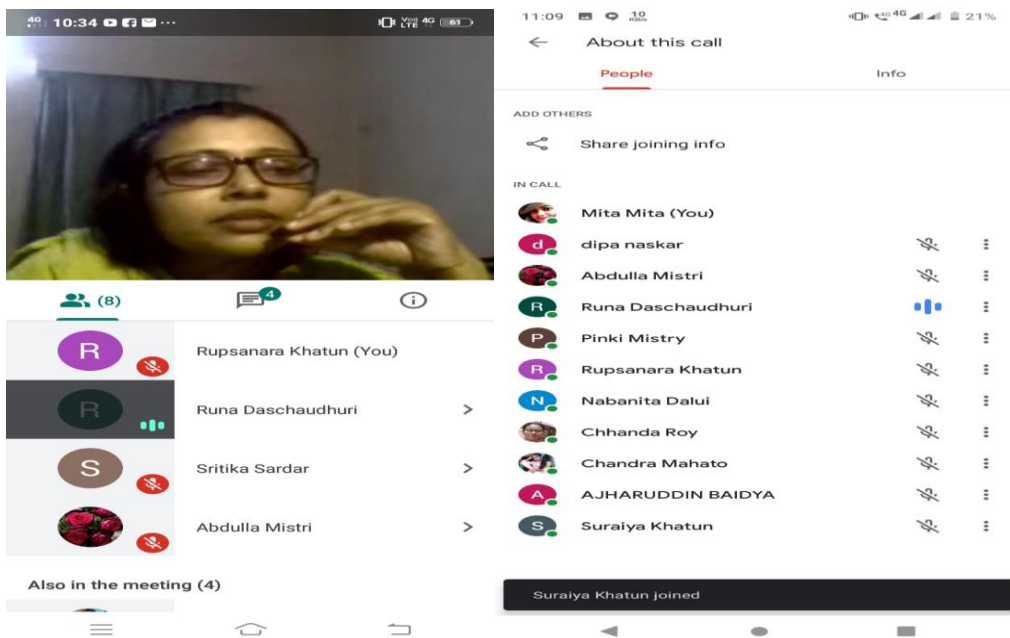
