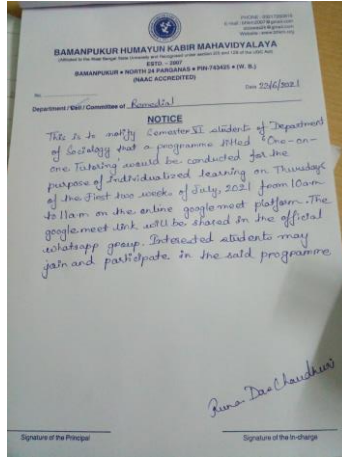
- **Objectives:**

The programme conducted for semester VI students of Sociology in June, 2021 saw success. On demand from students, the instructor of the course designed a short one on one tutoring classes. It was felt that specifically, one-on-one tutoring would help students focus on a specific task or subject, and allow them to experience a different kind of learning to potentially reach new skill and confidence levels.

- **Details of the programme:**

In the course of teaching process during regular class lectures, slow learners and under achievers were identified. The head of the department of Sociology initiated this programme to keep a record of the academically poor students. A total of four students participated in the programme. The personalized and individual attention given to the students helped them overcome their learning difficulties. Moreover, the student teacher interaction was more live in remedial coaching hours than in regular classes. The programme was conducted for sixth semester students from 10a.m. to 11 a.m. once a week on two Thursdays on 01/07/2021 and 08/07/2021.Four students, Subroto Sanfui, Chandra Mahato, Pinky Mistry and Abdulla Mistry were accommodated for the programme but a few other students wanted to be present for the classes as non-participatory audience and were allowed to join the session.

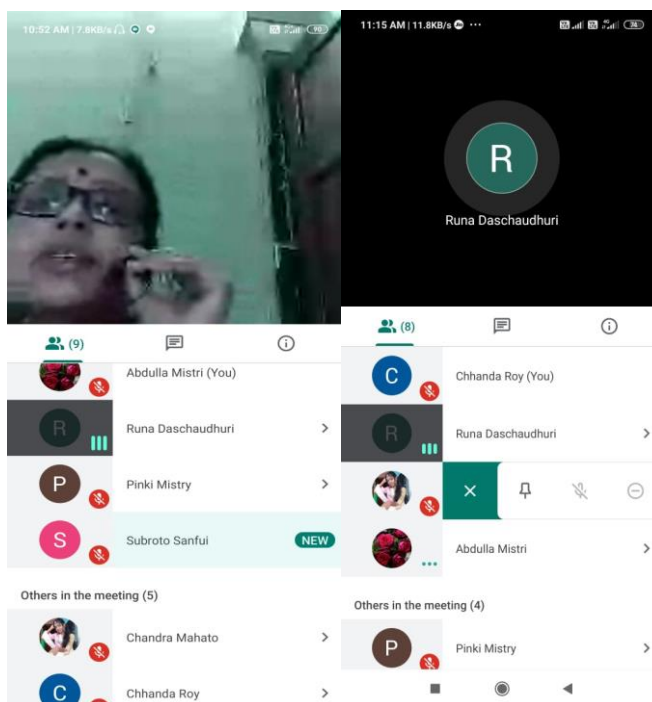

Outcome of the programme:

Students' feedback showed that students found the programme to be beneficial. One of the suggestions that came up was that the majority of students preferred evening session rather than morning classes conducted. Students also wished for more remedial teaching hours for other disciplines also and also to include students who are interested to attend the class in addition to weak students.

Thus, in spite of many misfortune this year also our college had done its best to organize remedial classes. Majority of the students come from poor economic and social background. The students feedback showed that the remedial hours provided them good academic knowledge besides giving them good support and confident in facing exams.
