Introduction:



In India, around 7 million people die due to air pollution each year, of which 4 million are killed by indoor air pollution. It is estimated that nine out of ten people in the world do not have safe air to breathe.

Objectives

It is also aimed at curbing pollution produced in industrial processes or due to human negligence.
