The Activity Report

The environment cell of Bamanpukur Humayun Kabir Mahavidyalaya organized a special programme named "Barsha Barana" or invitation to the Rainy season through tree plantation programme. The programme was organized on July 31, 2019, in the college garden.

The aim of this programme was to invite the rainy season and promote environmental awareness among the students and staff of the college. The programme was well-received and attended by a total of 43 participants, including 28 students and 15 staff members.

At the start of the programme, our Principal Dr. Subhash Biswas gave a brief introduction about the importance of trees in the environment and how they help in the conservation of natural resources. This was followed by a demonstration of the proper techniques for planting trees.

A total of 25 saplings were provided for the plantation activity. The saplings were of different varieties such as different flowers like Rangan, Rose etc. and some fruits like palm (Kul). The participants were divided into 3 groups and assigned a specific area in the garden for the plantation.

Each group worked together and planted the saplings with great enthusiasm and energy. They also took turns to water the saplings and ensure that they were properly placed in the soil.
