This day commemorate the signing of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act into law on this day in 1975 (IDEA). The programme started with the inaugural speech of principal BHKM. He explained that Special education is instruction that is specially designed to meet the unique needs of a child with a disability. This means education that is individually developed to address a specific child's needs that result from his or her disability. The welcome address was given by Prof Sumita Chatterjee convenor and organizer of the seminar. students of the Pratham Padyakhep performed dance and music. Swarup Naskar was felicitated by principal BHKM Next in her paper 'Special Education Day the concept "presentation session she discussed about Samuel Kirk who is recognized for his accomplishments in the field of special education, while sometimes being referred to as the "Father of Special Education". He began his teaching career at the Oaks School in Chicago in 1929, where he worked specifically with boys who were delinquent and had mental disabilities. It was during this period that advocacy led by the National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) resulted in the consideration of special education by the National Commission on Teacher (NCT) – 1 (1986), NPE (1986), and finally, by the Ramamurthy Committee in 1990.
