To convey the importance of the life and works of Rabindranath Tagore to the students.

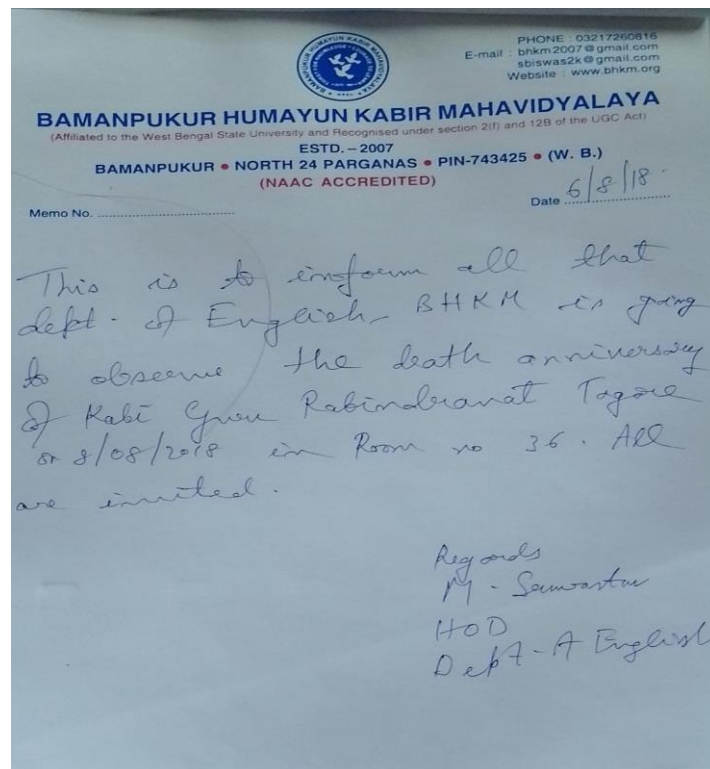
Report:
