INTRODUCTION AND ORGANIZATION

The Department of Education of Bamanpukur Humayun Kabir Mahavidyalaya organised Swachh Bharat Abhiyan to Christian para, adopted village of NSS. The requisite permission was sought from the principal of the college for the same, and the allotment of time and date was confirmed. Notice and programme brochure were circulated to the students and the teachers accordingly.

Swachh Bharat Abhiyan is one of the most popular and significant missions in the History of India. This campaign was introduced by the Prime Minister, Narendra Modi, and was launched on 2nd October 2014 to honour Mahatma Gandhi's vision of a clean country. Prime Minister of India Narendra Modi received the award of "Global Goalkeeper" from the Gates Foundation for the initiative of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan on September 25, 2019, in New York. Initially, this Swachh Bharat Abhiyan campaign was run on a national level in all the towns, rural and urban area.
