Activity Report

On 10th May, 2022, the Department of Bengali at Bamanpukur Humayun Kabir Mahavidyalaya celebrated Rabindranath Tagore's birth anniversary with a program called "Kabi Pranam" at the Seminar Hall of the college from 12 pm to 3 pm. The program was organized by Dr. Ajijul Hoque Mondal, Assistant Professor, Department of Bengali, BHKM.

The program began with a beautiful rendition of Tagore's song, "Pran Bhariye Trisha Hariye". Dr. Subhash Biswas, Principal, BHKM, delivered an inaugural lecture. He spoke about the life, works, and visions of Tagore, including his contributions to literature, humanism, politics, and farming. The lecture was very informative and enlightening.

Students Bulti Pramanik, Pritilata Mondal, Shiuli Khatun, and Suparna Das recited poems by Tagore and also shared their thoughts about the great poet. 
