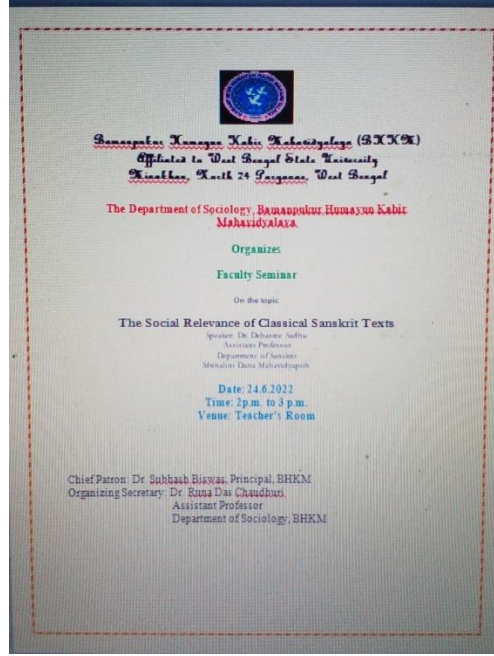
NOTICE
