Since 2008, November 11 has been commemorated as National Education Day to honour the birth anniversary of independent India's first education minister, Maulana Abul Kalam Azad. He has made significant contributions to education, nationalism, and institutional development. He is India's prominent educational architect. Azad believed that schools are laboratories where the country's future people are created. He is the brains behind the Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs). Then in second session prize distribution ceremony was organized y Dr Ajijul Haque Mondal. The programme ended with the vote of thanks by Dr Arghadip Paul IQAC co- Ordinator BHKM.




