Plan of the Programme: A meeting of the Extension cell under the convenorship of Ashis Biswas, Assistant Professor of the Dept. of English regarding the confirmation and execution of the rally was held on 15th February, 2020. In the meeting it was confirmed that the rally would be organised by the Extension cell in collaboration with the Dept. of Bengali. Ashis Biswas was selected as the Convenor of the Programme and Debraj Howlader, Assistant Professor of Bengali was selected as the Organising Secretary of the Programme. Dr. Md. Nasir Uddin Mondal was selected as the member of the organising committee. 21st February, though an enlisted holiday for being the day of MahaShivaRatri was nonetheless decided as the day of

the execution of the rally, and the allotted time would be from 10.30 am to 11.30 am. In the meeting the resolution was taken that dignitaries such as Prof. Subrata Chatterjee, Principal of Sri Chaitanya Mahavidyalaya, Prof. Aniruddha Chaudhury, former T.I.C. of Hiralal College, and Prof. S.A.H. Miruddin, former Professor of Varanasi Hindu University would be invited as Guests of Honour. And the invitations were sent to the proposed dignitaries and they cordially accepted the invitation. A Notice was circulated among teachers and students and other college staff on 18th February, 2020; though previously students and the college staffs were made aware of the scheduled programme by the members of the Extension Cell and the others. The members of the extension cell including Paramita Mondal and Dr. Runa Das Chaudhuri and the Organising committee members with the help of the student-volunteers prepared all the necessary articles such as banner, festoons, mike, flag etc. needed for the execution of the rally prior to the day of the rally.

Execution: On the Day of the Rally students gathered at the college campus and made two cues. After this the rally was disbursed and students went to the seminar hall to participate in farther proceedings of the day.
