Bamanpukur, 13th January 2020: The Extension and Extracurricular Cell of Bamanpukur Humayun Kabir Mahavidyalaya organised a rally to observe the Yuva Diwas, the birthday of Swami Vivekananda (12th January). The itinerary of the rally was from the college campus to the Christian Para. It was one of the core programme of the cell. The members of the extension cell and the Organising committee members with the help of the student-volunteers prepared all the necessary articles such as banner, festoons, mike, flag etc. needed for the execution of the rally prior to the day of the rally. The Principal of the college, Dr. Subhash Biswas, gave his inaugural speech on the importance of the day and the contribution of the great sage Swami Vivekananda. The students then read out the Swadesh Mantra. Thereafter the Principal flagged off the rally commenced at 11.15 am. Zeal and enthusiasm was oozing out of the participating students and teaching and non-teaching staff. The rally continued from the college campus to Christian Para and the way back to the college campus. People gathered on the

side of the road in the market place and other areas near to the college to watch the rally. The purpose of the rally was to take these programmes to the people of the locality outside the college campus. The Rally after completing its tour from the Christian Para reached at the college campus at about 12.00 pm. The students again gathered in the college campus in cues. The convenor of the Extension Cell and the organising secretary of the programme, Ashis Biswas then gave the vote of thanks to all the present teachers, non-teaching staff and students and the organising committee members. After that the rally was disbursed and students went to the seminar hall to participate in farther proceedings of the day.
