Activity Report

Dengue fever is a viral infection that is spread by the Aedes mosquito. It is a common and potentially fatal disease that affects millions of people worldwide every year. In India, dengue has become a major public health concern in recent years, with thousands of cases being reported every year. To increase awareness about this disease and its prevention, a dengue awareness program was organized in Room No 14 on 10th November 2017, with the help of BDO Minakhan and the Principal of BHKM. The program was attended by 36 participants, including students, teachers, and staff members of BHKM.

The Principal of BHKM inaugurate the programme with a brief overview of the transmission of dengue fever and the factors that contribute to its spread. He explained that the Aedes mosquito, which is responsible for the transmission of dengue, breeds in stagnant water and is most active during the day. He stressed the importance of eliminating breeding sites for the mosquito, such as discarded tires, flowerpots, and other containers that can collect water. BDO Minakhan, started the session by explaining the symptoms of dengue fever, which include high fever, severe headache, joint and muscle pain, and rashes. He emphasized that early diagnosis and treatment are crucial for the successful management of dengue fever.

The Second resource person then discussed the various preventive measures that can be taken to avoid dengue fever. He explained that wearing protective clothing, using mosquito repellents, and sleeping under mosquito nets are effective ways to prevent mosquito bites. He also advised the participants to use mosquito screens on windows and doors to prevent mosquitoes from entering their homes. Additionally, he stressed the importance of maintaining cleanliness and hygiene in and around homes and workplaces to prevent the breeding of mosquitoes.

The session ended with a question and answer session, where the participants asked various questions related to dengue fever and its prevention. The resource person answered all the questions patiently and provided additional information where necessary.

Overall, the dengue awareness program was a great success, with the participants gaining valuable knowledge about the prevention and management of dengue fever. The program helped raise awareness about the disease and its potential consequences, and encouraged the participants to take necessary precautions to protect themselves and their families from dengue fever.
