- Regular participation of girl students in cultural, sports, literary etc activities.

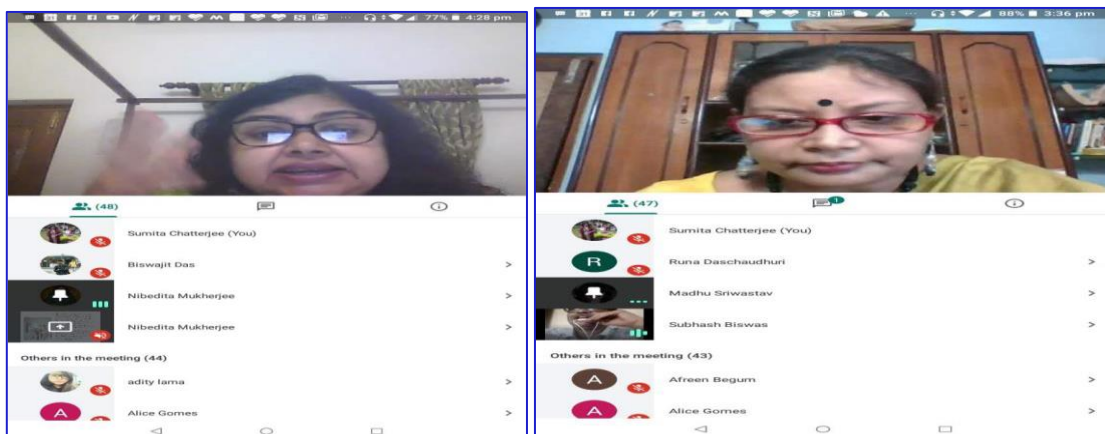
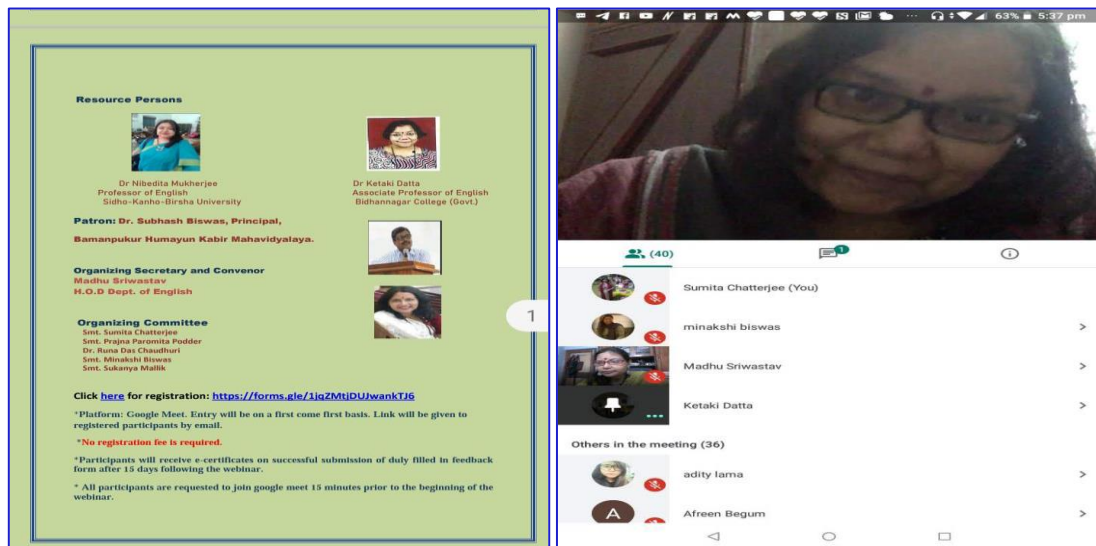

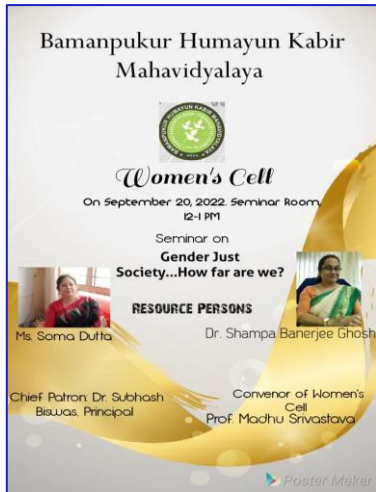

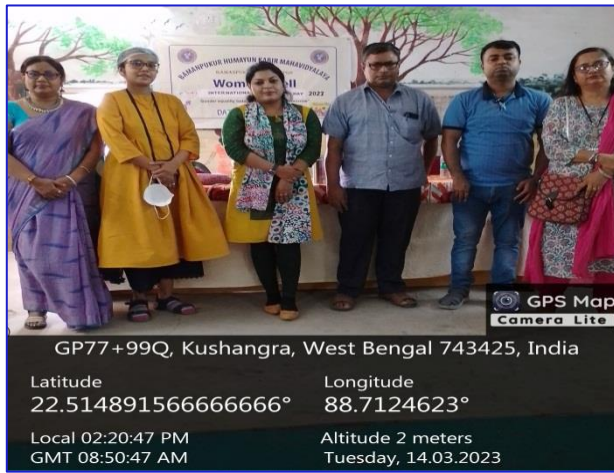
Above: Glimpses of Seminar on Women's Rights- 11.09.2017
