Rapporteur's report

OBJECTIVE OF THE SEMINAR

The workshop is aimed

- ➤ to generate awareness about Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) in all the sectors,
- to promote and encourage the creation of new intellectual goods, protection of those goods & enforcement of the IPR amongst various stakeholders,
- ➢ to give idea about Indian Patent System and related laws,
- ▶ to discuss regarding the procedures and practices for filing patent applications
- to train the participants about the mechanism of accessing and using IPR information for further research and development
- ➤ to suggest steps for transforming innovations into proprietary assets.

WELCOME ADDRESS: 2pm – 2.10 pm

At first Sukanya Mallik, Librarian of BHKM (organizing secretary of this state level seminar) started with greetings & warm welcome to all participants and she told some words on the necessity of IPR and need of plagiarism too. She also added IPR is essential for better identification, planning, commercialization, rendering and thus the preservation of inventions, innovation or creativity can be done. She discussed about the primary function of intellectual property rights (IPRs) which aims to protect and stimulate the development and distribution of new products.

FELICITATION OF RESOURCE PERSONS: 12.10pm-12.15 pm

Librarian Sukanya Mallik introduced Dr. Partha Sarathi Das with the audience by briefing his bionote. Dr. Partha Sarathi Das has more than 15 years of professional experience and is currently serving as Assistant Library & amp; Information Officer at the National Library, Govt. of India, Ministry of Culture. He has published around 39 publications includes journal articles, conference paper and book chapters. Dr. Das is an International Network of Emerging Library Innovators India - Innovator and Mentor of South Asia, which is a global library leadership capacity building programme supported by the Global Libraries Initiative of the Bill & amp; Melinda Gates Foundation.

After his introduction, both the eminent speakers Dr. Das and Principal Sir were felicitated by the students with nice flower bouquets.

INAUGURAL SPEECH and IDEA SHARING by Dr. Subhash Biswas (1st Resource Person): 12.15pm- 12.30pm

After these greetings, Dr. Subhash Biswas, Principal of BHKM was invited on stage to deliver his valuable speech on IPR. He started his lecture by giving an idea on Intellectual property (IP) which is an intangible property and can be produced through human intellect. He added that IPR is needed to provide legal protection to intellectual creations and to give proper recognition to the efforts of creators and inventors. He told that it helps to facilitate fair trading by preventing the infringement of proprietary rights of creators in their creations from unauthorized use.

Then he gave emphasis on geographical indicator (GI) which helps to promote economic prosperity of producers of goods produced in a geographical territory. He highlighted that GI is used to identify a product that originates from a specific geographical area having some distinctive quality, reputation and other characteristics which are essentially attributable to its geographical origin. Then he finished his speech after sharing some concepts on patent and trademark and asked the students to be aware of IPR for protecting the creativity and innovations.

LECTURE by Dr. Partha Sarathi Das (2nd Resource Person): 12.30pm – 1.15 pm

Dr. Das started his speech by saying some words on National Library as he is serving as ALIO, National Library. He informed students about the procedure of getting membership of national library and also shared the link of the India culture portal (<u>https://indianculture.gov.in/</u>) which has been newly launched by Ministry of Culture which hosts the cultural relevance of various repositories & institutions of India. Then he focused on different aspects of IPR through his PPT.

He started his session by describing the nature of intellectual properties like its intangibility, time-bound and territorial features. Then he discussed about the basic principles and history of international treaties. He highlighted the concepts of major intellectual properties and related IP laws in India. Then he told about moral rights (right of authorship, right of integrity, inalienable rights etc.) and different kinds of economic rights like right of reproduction, right of distribution/issuing copies, right of communication to the public, adaptation rights, right to make a cinematograph film or sound recording, translation rights, rental rights and so on. Dr. Das discussed about the duration of copyrights, performers' rights and rights of broadcasting and organizations.

Then he started talking about patents. He discussed about not patentable inventions. He nicely elaborated the differences between copyright and patent. He mainly told about 4 main categories of patents i.e. utility patent, provisional patent, design patent, plant patent. Finally, Dr. Das delivered his lecture on industrial designs.

INTERACTIVE SESSION: 1.15pm – 1.25pm

Teachers had so many queries regarding Geographic Indicator, self-copyright issue, duration of copyright and patent etc. Dr. Das described all the answers nicely and told to contact them through mail if further required.

CONCLUSION

The session was nicely ended with the vote of thanks delivered by Mr. Ashis Biswas, Convenor of ICT Cell. All the students and teachers got benefitted through this session and requested Dr. Das to come and deliver lecture further.
